- 4. Principal's Report:
- Fiona provided an update on College events that had occurred in the past month including the Dance & Drama Evening which was identified as a College event that P&F could support in the future.
- 5. Treasurer's Report Sophie provided an update on the following:

Account balances:

- At the 30 May 20149 there was \$3,148.75 in the P&F Operating Account and \$28,580.15 in the Term Deposit.

Fundraising:

- The money raised by Sophie and the P&F during the College Musical was directed to Performing Arts. It was noted by the Committee that the money needs to go to P&F first and then be distributed.
- A total of \$1,275.00 was raised through the sale of the tea towels.

The Committee is querying the payment to the Tasmanian Catholic Schools Parents Council for the School College Community Levy to understand what it is used for.

6. Fundraising:

- The School Play has been postponed to Week 3 in Term 3. Sophie is organising a Canteen to be run in conjunction with the Play with the theme 'Fairy Weddings'. Karen is helping with cooking and Amanda and Rebecca with lolly bags.
