

## **The Friends' School - Term 3 COVID-19 Sport Expectations**

As part of the Return to Sport Plan, the following guidelines are in place at our School venues. Other Schools and venues will have similar expectations in place.

### **The Friends' School Venues - Bell St and WN Oats Centre**

Your compliance with the expectations below is essential during Term 3 to support safe student sport participation.

Some important requirements for students and parents/guardians:

- If you or your child have a fever, cough, sore throat, flu symptoms or shortness of breath please stay at home and we strongly recommend you consult the COVID-19 hotline.
- All students and spectators are required to sign in at the venue for COVID -19 tracing purposes. There will be a compulsory check in point at WN Oats Gym and Bell Street entrances. **ONE SPECTATOR PER CHILD ONLY PLEASE**
- A Friends' School COVID-19 Safety Officer will be at each game venue and is responsible for collating attendance. These records will be kept in a secure location and destroyed after 21 days.
- Hand sanitiser stations will be located at both venues and are to be used when before and after games.

#### Ground Entry

- Entry to **Bell Street - main oval and top oval** - via main gate (Queens walk)
- Entry to **WN Oats Gym** via Commercial rd or Carr st.
- Both locations will be continued to be signposted with COVID-19 related hygiene signage.

The Tasmanian Government has recommended that spectators be kept to a minimum.

- Students should be ready in their playing uniform.
- No non-essential persons permitted in change rooms.
- Players and Officials to wash hands or use sanitiser prior to and after training and games.
- Observe advertised protocols at all venues.
- Spectators are to practice social distancing at all venues.
- Sporting equipment such as balls and cones will be sanitised after use.
- Each individual student will need their own labeled drink bottle.
- No sharing of drink bottles and towels.

External venues may have protocols in place regarding meeting points and pick-up/drop off zones. This information will be communicated prior to the game.
