

Uniform Requirements

- Years 1 – 6 students are to wear full tracksuit to school on PE lesson days.
- Years 7 – 10 students are to wear full summer or winter uniform to and from school.
- Blazers and boaters are to be worn to and from school each day including on buses travelling to or from the city, unless an announcement is made indicating otherwise.
- Secondary students involved in three or more College activities in one day, requiring the wearing of the College Sports Uniform, may request a Uniform Exemption Card, giving them permission to wear their College Tracksuit to and from school.
- Secondary students in Terms 2 and 3 may wear full College tracksuit to the College when the student has two periods (minimum) of sport-related lessons.
- College bike shorts/leggings are not to be worn to and from the College they are only to be worn in PE lessons.
- Students involved in after school training or sports competitions may wear full sports uniform home.
- A high standard of personal presentation is expected of students at all times and care should be taken to keep uniforms in good condition. If a uniform is soiled or damaged and requires repair or cleaning, **the complete reverse season uniform is to be worn, not the sports uniform, e.g. the summer uniform is to be worn if the winter uniform is being cleaned/repared.**
- All students must ensure their summer and winter uniforms are worn at knee length.
- In accordance with the College Sun Protection Guidelines, students are encouraged to wear the College bucket hat or College boater, which protect the face, neck and ears, when outside at recess, lunch breaks or while involved in other outdoor activities, from the beginning of September to the end of April. Students without a sun-safe hat or clothing are encouraged to remain in the shade.
- The College cap will be permitted for use for approved sporting activities where the use of a sun-safe hat is impractical.
- Hair over collar length must be fully tied back with a regulation navy or white ribbon or headband. Any clips or combs used should be in neutral colours. Extreme hairstyles are unacceptable, including obviously dyed hair, hairstyles that incorporate two starkly contrasting shades such as bleached blonde and dark brown, hair dyed black and hair bleached very blonde. If a student's hair colour or style is unacceptable she will be required to alter it within a set period of time.
- A watch and small plain silver or gold sleepers or studs, including small pearls and clear diamante, may be worn (only one earring per lobe.) One clear plastic piercing retainer is permitted in the ear lobe only. **No other facial piercings are permitted.** Students will be asked to remove other jewellery and it will be held in the College Office, clearly labelled, to be returned at the end of term.
- Students are not to wear coloured nail polish, acrylic nails or makeup with their school uniform. An excessive amount of fake tanning products is not permitted.
- Pants form part of the formal uniform.
- Where extra warmth is needed, navy school scarves may be worn with the winter uniform.
